The school year is divided into 2 semesters and a summer term.

First semester: 13th August ~ 19th December 2025
Second semester: 12th January ~ 19th June 2026

■ Summer School: June ~ July 2026

■ Half day program: 8.30 am – 12.30 pm

■ Half day + school program: 8.30 am - 1.30 pm

■ Full day program: 8.30 am – 2.30 pm

Arrival Time: Between 8.00 – 8.40 am.
Afternoon supervision: up to 3.30 pm

After-school activities: 2:40 - 3.30 pm

After school supervision: up to 4.00 pm

Enrollment

Enrolment is at any time during the year. All payment is done only in Thai Baht

Discount

Discounts on registration and tuition fees will be applied for siblings who are in the school at the same time as follows:

- ➤ 2nd child: 10,000 off on registration & 5,000 off on tuition fees / semester
- > 3rd child: 20,000 off on registration & 8,000 off on tuition fees / semester

Curriculum

Kids Kingdom International Kindergarten is a member of the International Preschool Curriculum (IPC), an organization which provides a comprehensive curriculum for preschools and kindergartens around the world. The IPC's preschool curriculum is a researched syllabus with a mixture of outcome; **objective**, **play and inquiry based learning approaches.** Designed by curricula experts, the curriculum is further peer reviewed by an advisory committee to ensure educational relevance and rigor. To ensure that the curriculum covers the developmental domains, there are seven core content learning areas which include numeracy, language arts, social and emotional skills, social sciences, creative and visual arts, technology and science, and physical development and motor skills.

Facilities

Staff

We have a professional working team here at Kids Kingdom who is always ready to assist you in any way that we can. Our teachers are qualified and experienced. Each class has a full time Teacher Assistant and a helper (for Nursery and K1). We have specialist teachers for computer, art & craft, Thai, yoga and music, gym, swimming etc

Snacks & Lunch

We provide healthy and nutritious snack and lunch to our students daily (please refer to school menu for details). Non-pork and vegetarian meals are also provided. All food is prepared on the premises each day.

Water dispensers are situated around the school and children are encouraged to drink water throughout the day.

- 1. Parents are requested not to send junk food or unhealthy snack to school.
- Snacks are also provided for students staying on for after school classes.
- 3. School must be clearly informed if your child has any food allergies.

Resources

Resources comprising of worksheets, workbooks, reading materials, etc. are provided for every student.

Field Trips

Students are taken on a field trip once or twice in a semester. There will be no extra charges for these trips.

Insurance

The school has insurance for students for medical expenses from accidents caused during school hours or on school trips. There is no separate charge to parents for this service.

School Transport

The school operates air-conditioned buses fitted with individual seat belts. Monitors are provided on each bus to take care of the students. Please check for more details regarding zones and prices.

After School Activities

We provide a varied after school program such as piano, gym, yoga, ball sports, Thai, art, ESL etc. Please refer to the after-school application form for more details.

Security

The school gate remains locked throughout the day. Visitors need to ring the bell to enter the school premises. No child is allowed to go beyond the school gate.

Pick Up Time

Each student is given a 'Student ID' card which is to be shown to our staff when picking up the child from the school or from the school bus. No child will be allowed to leave the school with any unregistered person. If there is any change to the usual routine the school must be advised in writing or phone call.

Parking

Parents and guardians need to be aware of children at all times when driving in the school lane / grounds. Cars can park along the correct side of the lane and also on both sides during morning (8.30 - 9.15) and afternoon hours (2.30 - 3.00). Parents are to be careful not to park in front of any gate.

Sicknesses / Absence

The school must be informed if your child is diagnosed with a contagious disease such as chicken pox, HFMD or has been in contact with any other infectious or contagious disease.

The school must also be informed if your child will be absent from school on a particular day or a particular period of time.

Contact

Phone numbers provided by parents must be reachable at all times. The school must be informed of any change of address or telephone number so that parents can be reached in case a need arises.

Special Events

Throughout the year, Kids Kingdom holds special events such as Christmas concert, Sports Day, International Day etc in which parents can watch their child perform or in events such as Teaching Demonstration day or PTC in which parents can learn more about their child's academic level and progress. Parents are requested to join in these special events.
